Over the past 10 years, seven St. Vincent's alumni were **valedictorians** at Nolan Catholic High School, Trinity High School, Fort Worth Christian, Grapevine High School, and St. James Episcopal School (CA).

In 2007, 100% of the fourth grade class qualified for the **Duke Talent Identification Program**.

In the past 10 years, seven St. Vincent's alumni were **National Merit Scholars**.

In its five-year history, the **St. Vincent's Chess Club** has won 10 U.S. national tournament trophies with two students taking 1st place finishes in their grade classifications.

On the 2007 **Stanford Achievement test**, Kindergarten students scored in the 89% in reading and the 92% in math. The eighth grade class scored in the 91% in reading and the 93% in math.

Since 2005, eight St. Vincent's students placed first in the **Private Schools Interscholastic Competition** regionally with three placing first at the state level in categories ranging from art memory, science, math, music memory, maps, graphs, and charts, and creative writing.

St. Vincent's teams play within the Christian Schools Athletic Fellowship. The teams have garnered the following:

- 2003 – The elementary boys' and girls' basketball teams placed first in the league.
- 2006 – The Elementary co-ed soccer team won their division championship.
- 2007- Elementary boys' and girls' basketball teams won their division championship.
The Middle School girls' volleyball team placed first in their division winning the championship.
The Middle School girls' team placed first in Track.

In the fall of 2007, 26 seventh and eighth grade students took the PSAT with the following results:

- Twelve students had a selection index higher than the national average for sophomores (128).
- Seven students had an SI higher than 143 which is the national average for juniors.
- Thirteen students had a higher score in writing than the national average for juniors (46).
- Eleven students scored as high as the national average for sophomores in math (44).
- Twelve students scored as high as the national average for sophomores in critical reading (43) and the state average for juniors (45).
